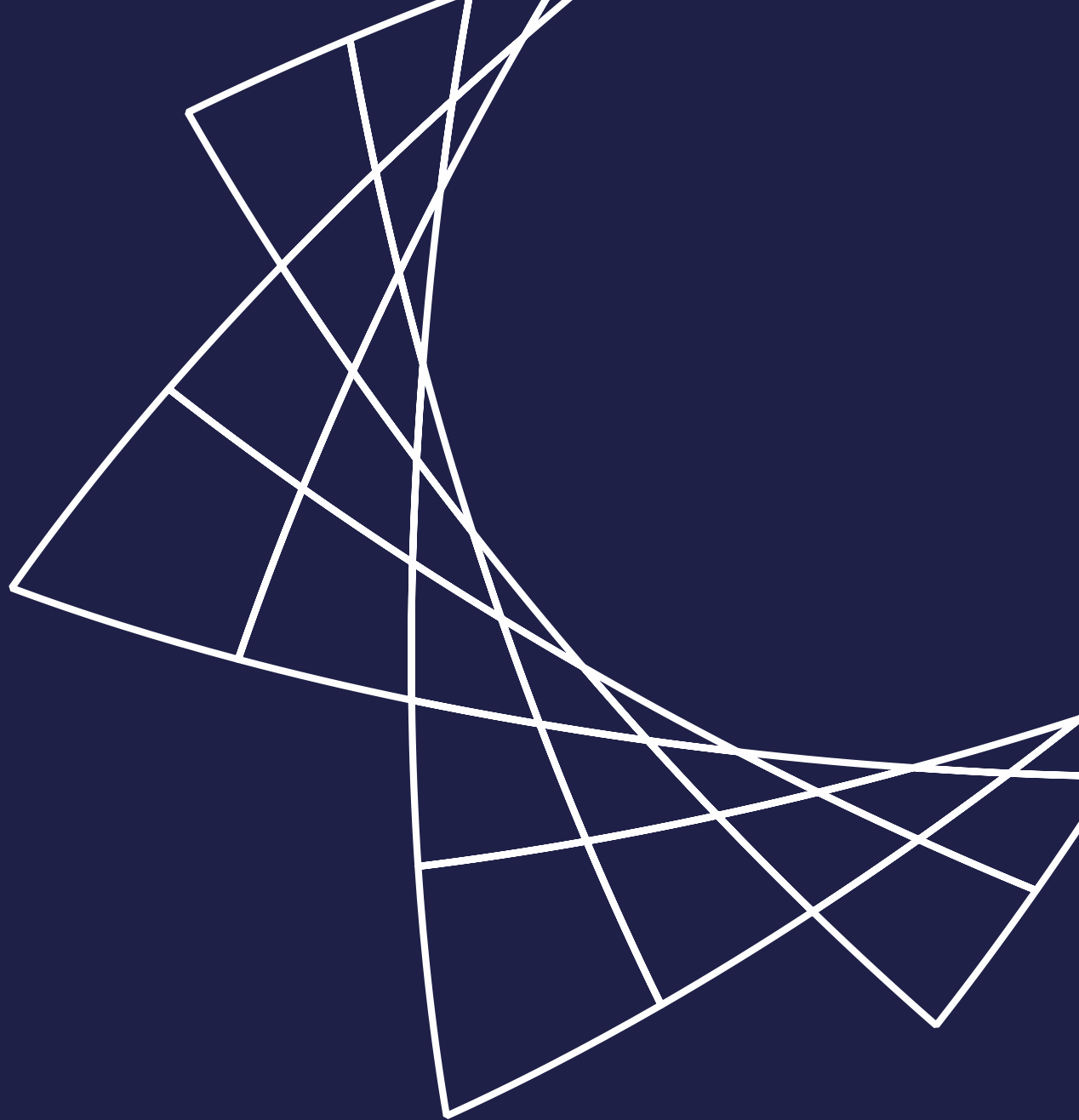

DOCUMENTATION, DEADLINES & TIME SCHEDULES

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

- Commercial Invoice/Packing List
- Insurance Cert (if available)
- Bill Of Lading
- Pre-Alerts

DOCUMENTATION DEADLINE

Four weeks before show opening date - **DO NOT MIX** temporary and permanent imports together in one case as this can cause delays in clearance and examination and will incur extra charges.

FREIGHT ARRIVAL DEADLINE

SEA FREIGHT – PORT KLANG (PKL) 20 working days before show opening date
AIR FREIGHT – KLIA (KUL) 10 working days before show opening date

PERMIT APPLICATION 1 month before show opening date

LATE ARRIVAL SURCHARGE

Shipment or Documentation arriving after specified deadlines subject to a surcharge **50%** of handling charges.

CONSIGNING, AIR / SEA FREIGHT INSTRUCTIONS

PACKING AND MARKING

Marking on all cases should be as follows:

EXHIBITOR'S NAME AND STAND NUMBER CASE NO.

DIMENSIONS (in centimeters) GROSS WEIGHT (in kilograms) NETT WEIGHT (in kilograms)

METHODS OF ENTRY

There are three (3) methods of entry for exhibitions in Malaysia :

a. **ATA Carnet** is by far the best method of entry. This method of entry is highly in order to expedite customs processing and clearance of exhibition documents.

b. **Permanent Imports** is used for items that will be disposed off or given away. There will be customs duties imposed for this.

c. **Temporary Imports**, a Bank Guarantee is put up by us on behalf of exhibitors for this method of entry. A service fee will be charged. (Please refer to the Tariff Handling Charges).

CUSTOMS TARIFF HANDLING CHARGES

Customs Clearance	USD 155.00 per shipment
Documentation Fee	USD 180.00 per shipment
Customs duties	At Cost + 7.5% advancement Fee
Change of status (temporary to permanent)	USD 155.00 per shipment

Bank Guarantee:

We will put up a Bond in the form of a Bank Guarantee for any temporarily imported goods on behalf of the Exhibitor for which we will charge a fee of 3% of the CIF value or a minimum of USD 250.00. This bond is valid for a period of one (1) month only. This is a service fee for putting up the bond on behalf of exhibitors and is non-refundable. (for extension: 2% of CIF value per monthly basis)
