AIRPORT TRANSFERS



Moscow has 4 international airports:

Sheremetyevo, Domodedovo, Vnukovo and Zhukovsky.



Due to the traffic in Moscow, **the fastest way** to get from the airport to your hotel or exhibition venue is by public transport.

You can take the Aeroexpress train from the airport to one of Moscow's main railway stations and then take the metro or a taxi.

For trips within the city, we recommend using the **metro**.

The train from Domodedovo arrives at Paveletsky station, from Sheremetyevo to Belorussky station, and from Vnukovo to Kievsky station. From Zhukovsky Airport you can take an airport shuttle bus.

SHOPS NEAR CROCUS EXPO AND FOOD DELIVERY

THEATRES, MUSEUMS & POPULAR SITES



Make the most of your time in Moscow by **exploring the city**, sightseeing, or visiting museums and galleries. Moscow's Hop-On Hop-Off buses allow you to go on a cruise of the Moscow River.

There are several famous museums and galleries in Moscow:

Tretyakov Gallery (Metro: Tretyakovskaya)

Pushkin Museum of Fine Arts

(Metro: Kropotkinskaya/Borovitskaya/Biblioteka imeni Lenina)

State Historical Museum (Metro: Okhotny ryad)

Bolshoi Theatre (Metro: Teatralnaya)

Other popular sites include Red Square, St. Basil's Cathedral, Lenin's mausoleum, the Kremlin, GUM (department store), Arbat Street, and Sparrow Hills.







MOBILE CONNECTION

For international calls, calls in Russia and Wi-Fi connection, it's best to purchase a Russian SIM-card.

Megafon's #Hello tariff is considered to be the best offer for international visitors. You can buy Megafon SIM-cards from: Sheremetyevo (Terminal D and 2) Other mobile service providers include MTS, Beeline, TELE2 and YOTA.

WiFi is widely available in Moscow including in public places, restaurants and at Crocus Expo (only with Russian SIM-card).

THINGS TO KNOW ABOUT RUSSIA



Climate:

It can get very cold in winter and very hot in summer in Russia, but most importantly, it is very changeable. Please check the weather forecast before your trip.



Cuisine:

Russian cuisine has a lot to offer and is well worth exploring. From the list above Traktir Pozharskogo offers Russian cuisine.



Language:

English is not widely spoken in Russia, even in tourist areas. We recommend downloading offline translators and dictionaries.



Culture:

As a fairly traditional society, Russia has certain rules and expectations that are followed. For example, when visiting Russian Orthodox churches women should cover their heads and wear long skirts (trousers are mostly allowed) and men should wear long trousers and remove any headwear. Dressing smartly is also important in theatres and

some restaurants.
