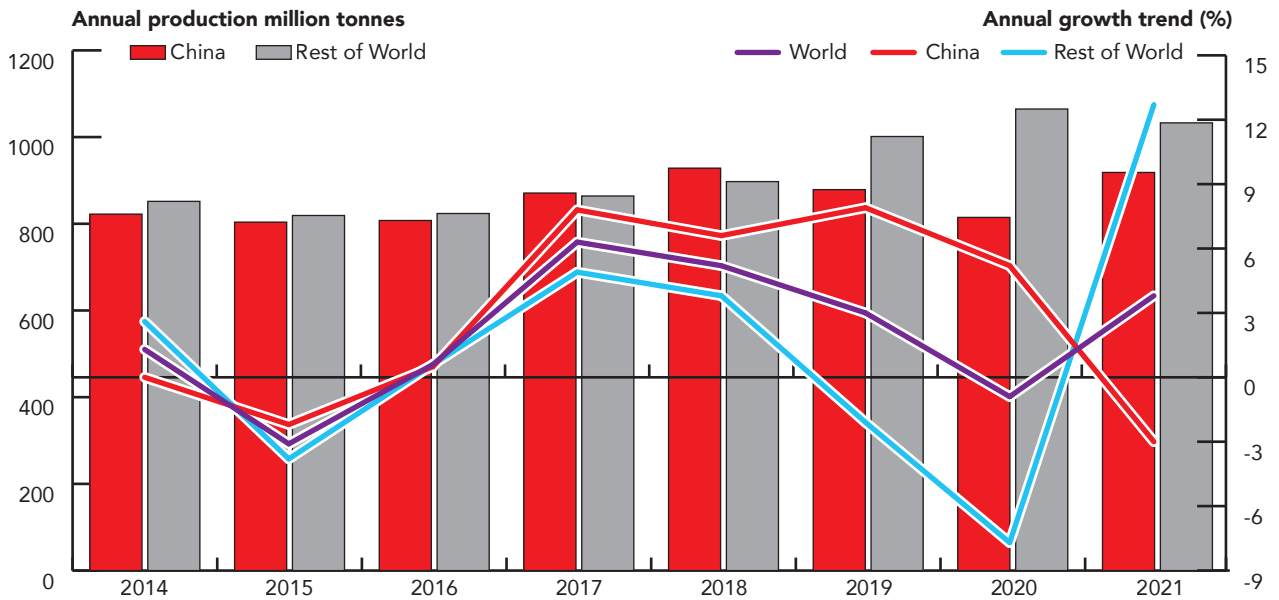




STEEL PRODUCTION
