In the forum where many leaders and innovators from all over the world come together to talk about the transformation to Zero Energy Buildings; technology sessions, networking opportunities and focused presentations will help discuss how to develop and transform the Zero Energy Building sector. Building owners, industry professionals and policy makers will share with forum participants how they use Zero Energy Buildings, how they improve outcomes, how they minimize uncertainty and risk, how they gain more control, and how these buildings enhance performance and well-being.



Yapı - Turkeybuild Istanbul Held in 2021 Reached a Turnover of 1 Billion Euros

Last year, the Yapı - Turkeybuild Istanbul, which hosted more than 250 exhibiting companies from 9 countries, reached a turnover of 1 billion euros between domestic exhibitors and foreign buyers. The exhibition, where the number of visitors per participant increased by 54 percent compared to the previous year, welcomed 16,899 visitors, 17 percent of whom were foreigners. As every year, 218 purchasing professionals from a total of 11 countries such as Morocco, Tunisia, Algeria, Cameroon, Georgia, Uganda, Nigeria, Pakistan, Lebanon, Sudan, Oman, Jordan, Azerbaijan, Kosovo were hosted at the exhibition as part of the VIP Foreign Purchasing Delegation programs held last year.

In addition to trade volume, the opinion leaders of the industry will discuss the development areas of the building, construction and real estate sectors will be determined, and what can be done to improve these areas. In Yapı - Turkeybuild Istanbul, participating companies will discuss points that reflect innovative, modern technology use in the industry, sustainable and environmentally friendly approaches with its visitors.

The Construction and Real Estate Sectors Continue To Grow

Looking at the economic figures and data obtained, the negative effects of the COVID-19 pandemic on all markets and sectors on a global scale have gradually started to weaken. According to information obtained from TURKSTAT reports, the construction sector, which contracted by 5.3 percent in the first half of 2020 due to the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic, grew by 3.2 percent in the first half of 2021. The real estate sector experienced stable growth in the second quarter of 2021, achieving a growth of 3.75%. On the other hand, construction expenditures increased by 35.1 percent in the first half of 2021 compared to the first half of last year at current prices and totaled 373 billion TL. In the first half of the year, the house sales to foreigners increased by 43.7% to 20,488.

The Building Industry Will Continue to Grow Thanks to the Export of Construction Materials

In the first half of 2021, construction materials industry exports increased by 49.9 percent to \$14.12 billion. On the other hand, construction materials imports increased by 34.4 percent in the first half of 2021 and reached \$4.26 billion. Industrial production of building materials grew by 32.1 percent in the first half of 2021.

Hyve Group's Regional Director Kemal Ülgen: "Now that the effects of the pandemic have started to weaken, we expect great activity and a high momentum in both the foreign and domestic markets at the 44th Yapı -Turkeybuild Istanbul, which we will organize in the field



of construction, one of the most competitive sectors in Turkey. Many of our exhibitors had already booked their places for this year's exhibition even before the exhibition ended last year." The new normal causes people all over the world to spend more time at home. People are trying to make their living space more comfortable. There is a similar situation in our country as well. However, besides this, the re-activation of the urban transformation due to earthquake risk in Turkey will also lead to remarkable growing of the construction sector."

Expressing that the exhibitions play an essential role in overcoming the economic recession in the world due to the pandemic, Ülgen stated that even if the effects of the pandemic have weakened, they will still host their guests by taking every necessary health precaution, and that they will be able to have much larger participation rates compared to previous years thanks to online participation options.
